## Statewide AG Directory Available as Member Benefit

*Falls Church, VA* - The Automotive Maintenance and Repair Association (AMRA), in conjunction with the Motorist Assurance Program (MAP), has prepared a directory listing contact information for each of the U.S. state Attorneys General and is making it available as a member benefit.

The ***Directory of State Attorneys General*** contains a listing for each of the 50 United States and the District of Columbia giving the name, office address and phone number for the person holding the office. The listing also provides the direct Internet URL for the Attorney General's office, the party affiliation for the office holder and the date when he/she was elected/appointed. The publication also provides listings for the U.S. territories, including American Samoa, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands.

The directory, which is available for download as a PDF in the Member section of the AMRA web site ([www.amra.org](http://www.amra.org)), is a companion piece to the monthly Directions Legislation Update. AMRA members receive an update on auto repair legislation introduced in all 50 states on or about the 15th of each month in PDF format, and it includes what action was taken, when the legislation will be/was passed and when it will be/was signed into law by the state governor. A web link to the proposed legislation is also provided to enable members to review it and determine the impact it may have on their day-to-day business.

"This directory is important for maintaining relations between state regulators, our member companies and consumers," said Barry Soltz, AMRA/MAP President. "By having access to this directory, AMRA members can directly lookup a state Attorney General's office using the Internet URL provided. The next step would be to look at the consumer affairs links to see if there are any automotive consumer issues their office is monitoring, which could help avoid unnecessary complaints."
